

## AIRPORT CONCESSION DISADVANTAGED BUSINESS ENTERPRISE (DBE) GOALS FOR FISCAL YEARS 2025 – 2027 WORKSHOP

As a recipient of federal funds, the Pensacola International Airport is required under 49 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 23 to establish an Airport Concessions Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (ACDBE) program. Under these regulations, recipient airports are required to establish goals for ACDBE participation in airport concessions opportunities if concession revenues annually exceed prescribed amounts. The goals are determined for a three (3) year period on a triennial basis. Pensacola International Airport is in the process of setting an overall ACDBE goal for federal fiscal years 2025, 2026, and 2027 (October 1, 2024 – September 30, 2027).

Interested parties are invited to attend this workshop to review the proposed goals and methodology and to provide any feedback that may assist in the development of the final ACDBE goal for the Airport.
